No Printer? No Problem!

When you finish creating your tags use the "Print PDF" option and save the PDF file. Printing your tags at an office supply store will save you ink (have them print in black and white, not color - it's cheaper!) and time. Don't forget to ask them to cut your tags!

STEP 1: GATHER YOUR ITEMS

Children cycle through a new wardrobe every 6 months, so it's no surprise you feel overwhelmed. It's time to gather everything they no longer wear or use. Check seasonal guidelines regarding what's in and what's out for each event.

The 4 C's Rule

IOW TO KNOW WHAT TO SELL



The newer it looks, the better it sells. Plan to clean clothes, shoes, equipment and toys.



Sell clothing and shoes in current styles and fashion. Make sure they're the right season!



Toys, games and puzzles must be sold as a complete set without missing pieces.



Compliant

Safety guidelines apply to selling a car seat, stroller, baby equipment and toys. Check https://www.cpsc.gov for recalls.

STEP 2: ORGANIZE



KEEP, SELL, TOSS (Have extra boxes or trash bags available)

- **KEEP** items that you aren't ready to get rid of yet.
- **SELL** items you want to sell. (Spring or Fall) TOSS - items that don't meet JBF standards.

- items, or throw them away. Separate the items in the **SELL** bin into Spring and Fall







STEP 3: PRICE & PREP

When you sell at JBF, you are in control of the price of each item. You also decide if it goes half price during our discount sale times. If the item doesn't sell, you can either donate the item to our local charity partner, or you can pick it up.



We recommend pricing at 1/3 of retail! Ask yourself, "What price would make me buy this item and brag about it to a friend?"

Bundle Items to Save Time

Create sets or bundles. Put an outfit together if they were purchased together, or a set of same-size onesies. Bundle Hot Wheels, or several superhero figures. Shoppers love it, and you only have to create one JBF tag!





MERCHANDISE PREP

BLANKETS & TEXTILES

PACKAGE: Receiving blankets can be placed in a

ziplock bag, larger blankets need to

be hung. Bundle blankets,

washcloths, and towels with ribbon or

string like a package.

TAG: If placed in a plastic bag, attach tag

securely with packaging tape to the outside of the bag and tape the bag shut. Make sure the barcode/QR code is not covered with packing tape, as the glossy tape can cause the barcode to not scan. If bundled with string, attach tag directly to blanket and tuck it under the ribbon/string so that it does not easily get pulled off.

PLEASE NOTE: We are unable to accept comforters, sleeping bags or bumper pads.

INFANT ITEMS

PACKAGE: Keep multiple pieces together. Working

batteries must be included, if

applicable.

TAG: Attach tag directly to item or clear self-

sealing bags with clear packaging tape

or hole-punch tag and tie to item

BAGS & BABY CARRIERS

PACKAGE: Zip-tie items to adult size hanger

TAG: Hole-punch JBF tag and attach to item

with a zip tie, ribbon, or string.

FURNITURE & EQUIPMENT

BRING A CAR SEAT WAIVER for all car seats, booster seats, or infant carriers. All must have a printed manual or digital access to the manual via printed QR code.

BRING A CRIB WAIVER for all cribs. Cribs must be manufactured on or after 6/28/2011, have all manufacturer/ warning labels attached and legible, and have a printed manual or digital access to the manual via printed QR code.

PACKAGE: If the item has multiple pieces, use



packing tape, zip-ties, or string to keep items attached together. If wooden furniture has loose parts, use clear plastic wrap to secure items. All furniture and equipment must be assembled. Batteries must be included, if applicable.

TAG: Loosely affix tag to item using painter's tape, or hole-punch the tag and tie it to item. Large ticket tag will

be provided at item drop off.

BOOKS, GAMES, DVDS, ARTS & CRAFTS

PACKAGE: Use clear self-seal bags or clear cling

wrap to hold multiple items together. Tie sets of books together with ribbon or string, face all binding the same way.

TAG: Attach tag to the book with tape that

can be removed without damaging the item (book tape, removable tape, artist tape, painter's tape, etc.) Hole-

punch tag and tie to sets.

PLEASE NOTE: Games & Puzzles must have all pieces. No "adult" content. Books have a 50 tag limit and DVDs have a 5 tag limit.

CLOTHING

PACKAGE: All clothing must be on a hanger.

Hangers should form a "?" with the opening pointing to the left when

looking at the item.

Attach tag using a tagging gun or with TAG: a safety pin. Tags must be located on

the upper right chest area of a shirt or upper right front hip of pants when looking at the item. Tags attached with a tagging gun should be attached through an **inside seam** or the

clothing's manufacturer tag and **not**

through the material of the item.

SIZES: Newborn to 14Y for boys and girls

Clothing Tips





Sets sell in smaller sizes. When making a set, safety pin the heavier item to the hanger, then pin the lighter item behind the heavier item on the hanger. They MUST be the same size.



Teens are picky, bring only your best. Brands matter, bring only teen brands. Think ae, lululemon, aerie, vans, nike, the north face.

SHOES

PACKAGE: Fasten shoes together with zip ties or

ribbon. Please do not sell shoes inside a shoe box, even if brand new. We do not have space to include shoe boxes, and they do not sell as well if the box

is included.

TAG: Punch a hole in the top of your tag

and attach the tag to the shoes with the ribbon, string, or zip tie. For a more secure tag, wrap packing tape around the top of the IBF tag (make sure not to cover the barcode), then hole-punch a hole through the tag and tape and attach to the shoes.

Check all items for safety recalls!

Battery-operated toys **MUST** include working batteries

TOYS

PACKAGE: Bag all small parts belonging to

toys/equipment in self-seal bags and tape the bag shut with clear packing tape. Fasten the bag securely to the item with ribbon, tape, or zip ties.

TAG: Attach tag directly to item with clear

packing tape or hole-punch tag and

tie it to item.
